

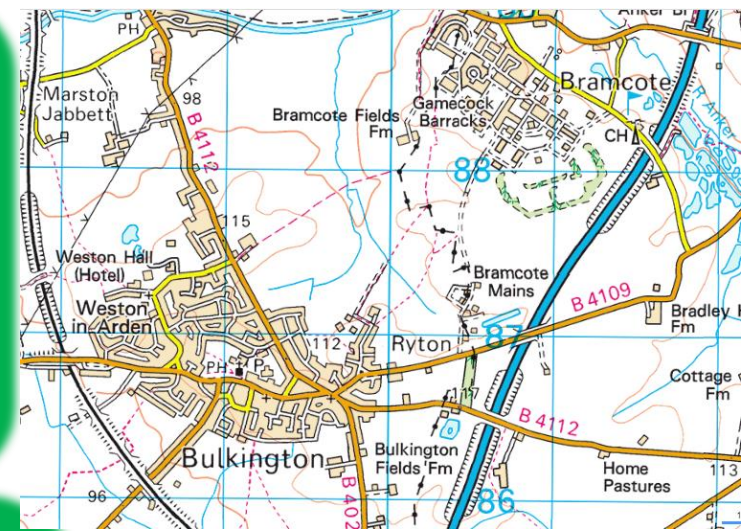

Belonging – Identity & Respect

We will be looking at the theme of 'Belonging', within this; the children will learn about what it means to belong to the Arden Forest family, and to the village of Bulkington. They will also explore and learn what identity and respect mean. They will learn about what has happened in the past in Bulkington including how schools and jobs have changed. They will also learn how to locate the village on a map; identifying key features in the local area.



Key Knowledge Content:

Our children will be taught:

- Describe changes and memories and changes that have happened in their own lives.
- Identify similarities and differences between periods of time.
- To devise a simple map; and use and construct basic symbols in a key.
- To use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of Arden Forest Infant School and its grounds.
- To understand geographical similarities and differences through studying the human and physical geography of a small area of the UK: Bulkington
- To use atlases, globes and google earth to identify the UK and its countries
