## Beyond living memory – the Titanic

### Belonging - Identity & Respect

In this topic, your children will use their skills as historians to investigate the events leading up to and the impact of the sinking of the Titanic in 1912.

As geographers they will also use world maps to map out the voyage of the Titanic.

As Artists, they will use their drawing skills to design plans for a model of a room on the Titanic.

As food technologists, they will learn to cook simple dishes, based on the dishes that might have been eaten on the Titanic.

### Core Skills:

Through this topic, your child will learn the following skills:

#### Geography

To use world maps, atlases and globes.

#### History:

To create timelines of events beyond living memory.

To use secondary sources to find out about an event.

To evaluate secondary sources.

#### Art


To use drawing and sketching skills.

To use sculpture skills, particularly involving card and paper craft.

#### Design Technology

To use cooking tools appropriately.

To use different cooking techniques to produce a final product



### Key Vocabulary:

**Capacity**– It is the number of people or things that something can hold.

**Luxury**- great comfort surrounded by beautiful and expensive items.

**Survivor**– Someone who has lived through a disaster.

**Funnel**- A metal chimney on a ship.

**Voyage** – A long journey on a ship.

**Disaster** – A very bad

**Lifeboat**- A small boat carried on a ship, used when people of the ship need to escape, if the ship is in danger or sinking.

**Belfast**- The Capital of Northern Ireland

**Southampton**- A port in south England

**Port**- A harbour for ships to stop and load people or objects.


### Key concepts:

**Identity** – knowing who or what a person or thing is, where you come from etc

**Respect** – caring how words and actions may affect other people. Listening to the opinions that others have even though they might be different to yours
